OWNER'S MANUAL



Water Game Installation

Read, understand and follow all instructions carefully before installing and using this product.

WARNING

- Assemble and disassemble by adult only.
- Use only under competent supervision.
- Only to be used in water in which the child is within its depth and under supervision.
- Not suitable for children under 36 months. Contains ropes. Risk of entanglement.
- This is not a life saving device. Do not leave child unattended while in use. See product for additional warnings.
- To be used with pool size 8' (244cm) and above; and wall height 48" (122cm) or lower.
- 1. Inflate each chamber slowly with a foot or manually operated air pump.

CAUTION: To prevent bursting, do not over inflate or use high pressure air compressor.

Close and recess all inflation valves securely.

Steps 3-5, for model with volleyball feature only:

- Thread the volleyball net string through the grommets located on the inner side of each inflatable pole (If applicable). Tie the free ends as you would tie shoelaces. Fasten the buckles in each side of the inflatable poles.
- To keep the inflatable poles straight and steady, adjust the buckle straps in each side of the inflatable poles.
- Follow the anchor weight installation instruction.
- For storage, reverse the set up procedures. Clean and air dry thoroughly before storage. Store in a dry place and indoors.

Anchor Weight Installation Read, understand and follow all instructions

carefully before installing and using this product.

- Inflate and assemble the floating structure first.
 - CAUTION: To prevent bursting, do not over inflate or use high pressure air compressor.
- Place the assembled structure on the water.
- Thread each rope through the grommets on the anchoring bags. There are two anchoring bags; each bag holds about 2 to 3kg (4.4 to 6.6lb) of dead weight. Do not exceed the recommended weight.
- For the dead weight, it is recommended to use pebbles or other similar small stones worn smooth by erosion of about 1 to 2 inches (2.54 to 5 cm) in size or diameter. IMPORTANT: Never use rough stones or stones with sharp edges or corners, as they may cause serious injury, damage the anchoring bags and the pool.
- Sand and other fine particles are not recommended as dead weight, they may fall or spill out easily from the bag, serious injury and property damage may occur.
- Clean the pebbles with a garden hose before placing the pebbles into the anchoring bags. You may wish to put the pebbles into a plastic carry bag first and then into the anchoring bag.
- Close the anchoring bag with the end of the rope. Pull the rope tightly and tie a knot as you would tie
- Make sure the anchoring bag is securely close and tight. Nothing should fall out or escape from the bag.
- 10. Slowly lower the anchoring bag into the pool until the bag sits on the pool's floor. Do not drop the bag suddenly into the pool as it may damage the pool's floor.
- 11. Tie the other free end of the rope to the grommet located on the inflatable structure. The anchoring bag must be resting on the pool's floor, the rope must be taut and the inflatable structure should be floating parallel to the water surface.
- 12. Repeat the previous steps with the other anchoring bag. Make sure the weights on each anchoring bag are equally distributed.
- 13. Place the whole assembled structure so that it will not obstruct or become a trip hazard to the pool user.
- 14. For storage, reverse the set up procedures. Clean and air dry thoroughly before storage. Store in a dry place and indoors.

NOTE: The anchor weights will not prevent the floating structure from moving during rough play, windy and gusty days.

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
